
Week 1: External Environment

UNDERSTAND WHAT IS MEANT BY SWOT ANALYSIS AND ITS PURPOSE.

· identify opportunities (seize) and threats (counteract) for a company

INDUSTRY

- group of organisations or business units producing close substitutes (include geographical element)
- Narrow definition makes it easier to analyse the industry but runs risk of missing new trends while wide definition run risk of getting lost in mass of data
- · Best to conduct country/ region specific analysis





MACRO ENVIRONMENT -> PESTELID FRAMEWORK

- · 2 questions:
 - · What major trends affecting future growth of the industry?
 - · Will this industry grow faster/ slower than average industry growth rates?
- Assess each issue identified as having positive or negative effect on growth of industry compared with average growth of industries in general
- Summarise +/- with regard to relative importance of each factor and make conclusion
- Step 1-Trend identified affect most of the industry and not just selected company
- · Step 3-Trend either opportunity or threat
 - P: political- Debt/ income level, immigration policy, healthcare funding
 - · E: economical- CPI Inflation rates, unemployment, GDP growth
 - · S: Social cultural- aged care, obesity, food demand
 - · T: technology- cheap global communication, 3D printing, cloning
 - · E: environmental- deforestation, greenhouse gas emission, global warming
 - L: legal- food contamination, utility disruption, tobacco health suits
 - · I: international- reduce trade barrier, changing foreign exchange rates, different labour rates
 - · D: demographic- immigration, population growth, birth rates

INDUSTRY ENVIRONMENT->PORTER'S FIVE FORCES OF COMPETITION FRAMEWORK

- Factors within the industry that affect both profitability and competitive position of organisations within it
- · Profitable if all five force are low
- · Start by identifying the industry of company analysing
- · Combine conclusion of each force and formulate if industry is attractive or not
- Notes:
 - · Step 3- Choose level of threat (high/low)
