

History of cognitive psychology



Models in cognitive psychology

Help psychologists to understand the big picture by organising data into a common schema and pose questions to be answered

<u>Process models:</u> visualise the process ("how" something works), called black box models (each square doesn't localise an area)

Structure models: visualise a specific brain structure

Currently use:

- 1. <u>Human information processing model:</u> process occurs in stages, permanent stored representations, central processor that manipulates information and mental operations
- 2. <u>Computational model:</u> interconnected neuron-like nodes that are linked rapidly through learning and process is due to statistical properties
