
## Lecture 3 - Phonemic and phonological awareness

What is phonological awareness?

• Understanding that speech can be broken down into smaller parts



Sequence of phonological awareness development

- 1. Can recognise whether two words rhyme
- 2. Can think of a rhyme for a simple word
- 3. Can isolate and pronounce the initial sound of a word
- 4. Can blend the sounds in 2 phoneme words
- 5. Can isolate and pronounce all the sounds in 2- and 3- phoneme words
- 6. Can blend the sounds in 4-phoneme words containing initial consonant blends
- 7. Can isolate and pronounce the sounds in 4-phoneme words containing initial blends
- 8. Can blend the sounds in 4- and 5- phoneme words containing initial and final blends

## Word level

- A single distinct meaningful element of speech or writing
  - → Used with others (sometimes alone) to form a sentence
