Ways infections Spread

- Patient to patient
- Staff to patient
- Environment to patient
- Patient to environment
- Patient to staff

Standard Precautions

- · Basic level of infection control
- Aim to prevent contact with
 - o Pathogens present in individuals blood or body fluids
 - Pathogens disseminated from a person's body or the environment
 - Reduce spread of pathogens from known and known sources

Techniques

- Hand Hygiene (5 moments)
 - o Before touching a patient and their immediate surroundings
 - o After touching a patient
 - After touching a patient's surroundings
 - o Before a procedure
 - o After a procedure or bodily fluid exposure risk
- Aseptic techniques in handling
- Cough etiquette

PPE

- Are specialised equipment worn to protect against infectious materials
- Include
 - o Gloves
 - o Sterile gloves
 - Surgical mask
 - Eye protection
 - o Gown
- Risk assessment of situation to determine what equipment is needed
 - Touch, splash, spray or large volumes of blood or bodily fluids that may penetrate the blood
 - Wound dressing or examination requires all equipment
 - BP measurement would not require any

Sharps

- Never
 - Pass
 - Recap
 - o Reuse

Linen Management

- Keep soiled clothes away from uniform
- Never fan linen
- Never place on the floor
- Making a bed should have bed raised to nurse's hip-level
- Return bed to lowest position to prevent accidental falls

Other Precautions

- Waste management
- Routine environmental cleaning
